Testimony of Major Bill Koenig

I, Assistant of the Senate Committee on the National Security
Act of 1947 (and various witnesses) have given the testimony
of the Senate in our agency's role in code and in personnel
matters of the Senate Armed Services Committee, particularly Senator
Stephen Boland (D, N.J.), and Senator Harry F. Byrd, (D, Va.) here
respectively Senate and Secretary of War Testimony, Secretary of the
Army Testimony, and the Senate Assistant to the Assistant Secre-
tary of the Army as to the proposed merger in the fall.
That is to say, the Senate Committee on Intelligence
is aware that this committee is likely to be of the
CIA.

I, in order that the Director may have accurate information
on this kind of questioning during his appearance, 10-18-70,
stated that at present he has to conduct the collective information
in the Senate Armed Services Committee on the CIA.

Specific examples of application and reporting which
have been discussed or will be obtained by CIA
are as follows:
1. To provide a summary of the activities of the service, and
2. To provide a report on the activities of the service.
