

Further to my letter of February 4, 1981, please note that I will be in the Washington area from February 20 to March 5, 1981 and can be reached at (301) 654-4910 or (703) 756-1205 for messages.

Some 30 students will be accompanying me to Washington in order to conduct interviews and to obtain briefings for their research. Enclosed is a list of their names, social security numbers, and topics of interest.

We would like to receive some overall briefings as a group and then to have individuals to meet particular OPA analysts. If it is not feasible to have the separate sessions, nevertheless, we would like to have general briefings that might cover some of the topics indirectly.
