

- 7. Johann MANZINGER, born 28 June 1925 in Vienna, was possibly one of Subject's contacts in 1952 for information about Danube ship-
- 8. Dr. Eugen (or Jenos) DECLEVA: was a close associate of Inre KLEIN. In 1950 DECLEVA reportedly peddled information of Josef VEHH, the Italians, the HED, and/or General ZAKO's organization.
- 9. Fam DIRTRICH, who was with the Huggarian Welfare Office in Salaburg in 1950, probably directed refugee sources to Subject.
- 10. Herbert DORNAL (a MALLENER), born 24 February 1917 in Marburg, recruited KCLLERYI to work for Rupert MANOL.
- 11. General Ferenc von FARKAS au KESSARMAK, formerly with the Hungarian Army, was trying in 1950 to assume leadership of the MHHK. He may be identical to the Ferenc FARKAZ (sid) who in 1950 worked at the MKS (formerly CIC) Screening Center in Salaburg after being placed there by Subject's recruiting team. He may also be identical to the Ferenc FARCAS, who by 1955 no longer worked for Subject and was the instigator of much conflict within Subject's group.
- Friedrich FRANK (V-14415), born 4 February 1909 in Pomerania, the Dat. 2 case officer who terned Josef GIMBBURG over to Subject.
- 13. Andrey GARZIK (G Andress EUER) worked at the MIS Screening Center in 1951 and gave refugee debricking reports to Bertalan SZEMDECHI (who passed some to KOLLENYI), to Fm TAKACS (for Detachment 35 in Line), and to Albin KAPITANYFY (for the French).
  - 14. Captain FunderEMECTER was in charge of the defensive intelligence section of Subject's group in Salaburg in 1950. He may be identical to Mihaly REMEMESTER, who was a Hungarian Mani agent in Switzerland in 1944.
    - 15. Lieutemant Erwin GEVAY was General ZAKO's adjutant in 1950.
  - 16. Josef GINSBURG (V-14921), born 24 March 1908 in Rumania, was asset whom Friedrich FRANK turned over to Subject about 1954.
- 17. Major Arpad GOSSY was an office worker for Subject's group in Salmburg in 1950.
  - 18. C was an interpreter for Heil SZALANCZY circa 1950.
- 19. Ymu WARVAS, like Fnu DIETRICH, worked in the Hungarian Welfare Office in Salaburg in 1950 and probably directed refugee sources to Subject.
- 20. Istvan HECHDUS (or HECHDUS) (V-17878 ?) was placed in the MIS Screening Center in Salaburg by KOLLENYI's recruiting team sometime before or during 1950. At that time, he was probably also associated with Hugo TRUX. By 1952 HECHDUS, using the alias of BARSONY, worked as a "leguan and fingerman" for Subject's group. By December 1953, however, he had broken with Subject and/or his group and reportedly tried to spread dissension within it for revenge.
  - Armad MENNEL apotted refugees which he referred to Subject.
- 92. General Gustav HHRNYHY, a former Hungarian Army officer, was the subject of at least one of acidanta's reports in 1850.

- 24. Langle HORI (or HORY) (V-14703), General ZAKO's secretary, was described in 1950 as an informant for Subject. Earlier an attacks at the Hungarian Babassy in Belgrade, he became a journalist in the
- 25. Isre ROMYATH may have been one of Subject's refugee sources in 1951.
- 26. Geza JELENCIS (V-14615), born 11 February 1929 in Hungary, occasionally visited the Carita's School in Salaburg in the early 1950's in the company of Kalman BOERZE, a self-proclaimed CIC border crosser. JELENCIS, however, was recruited by the BMD in January 1951 as a border crosser and a "flying observer." He was one of the agents whom KOLLENYI directed, but he had been dropped by 1954.
- 27. Father JOSEF, with the West Bahnhof Mission in Vienna, was in contact with Subject about 1951, probably in connection with Father JOSEF's interest in Caritas Mission work.
- 28. Oliver KADAR was a refugee whom Subject debriefed in 1950. Subject later denied that he had debriefed KADAR and asked Hugo TRUX to forget that he had earlier admitted this to TRUX.
- 29. Ferenc MARTOR (Y-14451), born 20 September 1922 in Rungary, was one of the agents whom ECHLERYI controlled for the BED during the early 1950's.
- Albis KAPITARRY was the CE man for ZAKO's organization(s) In 1950 be give MHEK information to Subject for the BHD and allegedly also gave information to the French.
- 31. Dr. Karl Kurt KLEIM, who worked for Subject in Salzburg in 1950 and who was the brother-in-law of Colonel ZSOLHYAI, may be identical to Dr. Esre KLEIK
- 32. Miklos KORPONAY, born 25 September 1912 in Szombately, was a member of the KOPJAS Group and worked for CIC in 1947. About 1950, when he was in charge of the Press and Propaganda Section of the MHSK, he drew up the agreement between KOLDENYI and the MHSK whereby KOLDENYI paid a regular sum to receive MHSK intelligence reporting. In 1951, however, ZAKO dropped him from the MHSK.
- 83. Yereno KOYACS (@ TARKADI-KOYACS) ran him own network into Hungary in competition with Subject as early as 1948, when KOVACS was invited to merge with ZAKO.
- 34. Andre TKOMA, who was with VOA, knew Subject as early as 1951 In 1955 be was responsible for blowing Subject and his activities to the AVH.
- 35. Baron Victor REUCHINA, a British IS operative in the "CHIO" in Millstatt, was a source for information MOLLEMYI and MCRFONAY collected for the CIC until circa December 1947 when MERUCHIHA severed his connections with them,
- 36. Bela LANCZY (V-17579/C), a member of the P(R) ICHLER group, debriefed refugees in various cales in Vienus in 1951. In 1952 be was described as a member of the GEOCZE (SZENDEOEI ?) group of intelligence swindlers in Austria. He alternately claimed to work for the French, British, END, and CIC.
  - 37. David LESZLI interrogated refugees in Vienna until 1951 when he migrated to Australia.
  - Aurel LISZAY (@ SZILASSY) received an invitation is 1949 from KOLLERYI to join him in Austria as an intelligence operative.

Lasslo (or Ladislaus) SZEXELY (@ Josef FROEHLICH) (V-10064), born 18 December 1924 in Source, was a close triend whom KOLLERYI had not in war college. 60. Bertalan SZEHDROEI (6 GOMCZE, 6 Bartolomeus P(R) ICHLEE) worked for CIC through Bela LANCZY and had sub-agents who reportedly traveled to Hungary. 61. Colonel Earoly SZETA (V-14801), born S April 1897 in Andrashida, was an agent handler in Det. 2 in 1950. Before the war, SZALÁRCZY had served under him in the G-2 Section of the Debrecen Army Corps in Hungary. 62. Dr. Kornel TARCZALY, born 20 May 1921 in Budapest, was described as the MHSK representative in Switzerland in 1950. 63. Vince TROLAS, a blackwarksteer and professional swuggler, was recruited by Sandor VISHTSY as a courier into Hungary. He participated in at least one exfiltration mission. Yiona TORCH was a friend of Oliver KADAR and Janos MARKOVITS, who used her residence in 1950 to meet their contacts, etc. 65. Janon Mik was a caretaker and debriefer at the Ledigenhein DP Camp in Vienna in 1951. 66. Jence TOTH (V-14886), born 8 May 1927 in Tertocendred, was a truck mechanic who lived in Salaburg in 1952. In 1951 he had been one of Subject's refugee sources. Hugo TRUX was a co-worker with KOLLENYI for CIC in 1949 and 1950. 68. IARRIO VIDRA was one of Subject's refugee sources in 1951. 69. Sandor VISITAT (V-14470), born 25 May 1917 in Hungary, was in contact with TRUX in 1950. He was in charge of offensive intelligence and agent training in Salaburg for Subject. He was reportedly kidsapped by the AVH and arrested in Hungary in December 1956. 70. Lassio VURAY (V-14761), born 6 June 1925 in Budapest, directed a radio intercept program in Austral but was termi-20 February 1964. Subsequently he went to work for CIC. 71. Andreas WEXSZ (V-14552), born 4 March 1929 in Smombathely, was dropped in December 1952. 72. Josef WEZWICS, a blackmarketer and professional swuggler, was recruited by Sandor VISHYHY as a courier into Hungary. He participated in at least one extiltration mission. 73. Jozsef AIKELY (V-14701). worked for Dat. 2 until he was dropped on 28 February 1954. 74. Mihaly ESOIMAY (V-17579/G) worked in "Project 34," probably under Karoly SZITA.
