1. The undersigned did not see the attachments to reference B and, unfortunately, we have not been able to locate them in station files. Therefore all we know positively about Dr. VOLLER is Reference A giving his last name only and reporting his claim to be an officer of the Grengulf service.

2. We would appreciate receiving a summary of Headquarters information on Subject, including full name and date of birth if possible. We wonder if he is possibly identical with the only VOLLER we have carded here, a

Dr. Leopold VOLLER, DOB 10 or 16 October 1911 at Murau, Steiermark, occupation correspondent, living in 1953 at Vienna 9, Berggasse 17/39.

None of the references to this man are retained in Station files (they date from 1950-53) but our card summary indicates that he was suspected of being a Soviet agent, engaged in radium smuggling, had connections to the KPOe and earlier to the Nazis, was listed as a CIC and Det. 35 informant in 1951, was the Subject of a G-2 query in 1953 and was reported to be of possible interest to the FIS and certainly known to the UPSWING organization which said he was a former KPOe member.

3. We would be interested in knowing if Leopold VOLLER is the same person whom [ ] encountered in Vienna. If he is, we would recommend caution in any contact with him until we can check him out further locally. The card record alone suggests or confirms ties to four different services, not including Grengulf, and the man, at the very least, would appear to be a peddler. He is certainly not an "officer" of the GRENGULF service, but quite possibly is run by them as a source on Communist front matters. He might be the source whom Grengulf 1 recently described to us as "not a party member but a fellow traveler with close personal ties to members of the KPOe Central Committee". We believe that this source is responsible for much of Grengulf's local Communist coverage.

4. There is no VOLLER listed in any of our current police directories. We feel certain that Grengulf 8 had reference to a Vienna Stepo case officer when he spoke of their "competent and experienced" man on Communist front operations, i.e., a police official who might be handling VOLLER rather than the latter himself.
