
Following a rash of firebombings on 24 March, the first anniversary of the military coup that ousted Isabel Peron from the presidency, the Montonero guerrillas announced that they will not engage in terrorism at the next World Cup soccer games, which are scheduled to be held in Argentina. In a communique mailed to the press, the Montoneros assured "players and technicians, fans, sports delegations and foreign journalists" that they need have no fear for their safety. The promise of temporary peace, unfortunately, offers little solace to those now in Argentina. The Wo The World Cup games do not start until July 1978.
