SUBJECT: **Col. FEY(?), CERMAKOVA, HOBAC, JUHAN, and BISICKY**

NOTE: Information from CAMEL was formerly relayed to us by PLESH, but during his absence (Cf. MSC-284, 51) it is given to us by WISCHMANN who is CAMEL's friend and business partner.

1. CAMEL has just received a Czech "Demarcation Certificate" (in Czech known as "Osvědčení o Státní a Národní", and is issued by the "Obvodní Rada pro Prahu I-VII"). This certificate declares CAMEL to be politically unincumbered and, therefore, allows him to return to Czechoslovakia anytime he wants.

2. The certificate was brought to CAMEL by American Col. FEY(?) and his secretary, CERMAKOVA, on their latest visit from Prague to Munich.

3. The interesting thing about all this is:
 (1) CAMEL who knows that his Prague apartment has been lately searched by the Czech police is very surprised to have received such a certificate.
 (2) CERMAKOVA, a Czech national, secretary of Col. FEY(?) of the American Mil. Attache's Office in Prague, is very friendly with a Czech Capt. Ivan HOBAC, with Franta JUHAN, and with Karel BISICKY. All three travel often from Prague through Munich to Switzerland. JUHAN and BISICKY are suspected by CAMEL to be members of QSS.

4. **COMMENT:** This info could be of possible use to SSG/Prague.
