SUBJECT: UPHILL/UPHILL/URANDOM

UPHILL REQUEST TO DROP TELEPHONE COVERAGE ON ALIAS RISCHKE/
 UNILATERAL COVERAGE ON UJREADFUL

1. ON 1 MARCH, IN THE COURSE OF A MEETING WITH ALIAS FLEMING AND FRI. KUNZE IN ORDER TO DISCUSS CERTAIN LCFLUTTER PROBLEMS WITH FRI. KUNZE CASUALLY HAULED OUT AN INFORMAL MEMO REQUESTING THAT TELEPHONE COVERAGE BE DROPPED ON RISCHKE, LOSIGKEIT, GRUENBERG, AND RUPPRECHT.

THE BEST MIGHT BE A SIMPLE STATEMENT THAT WE BELIEVED CONTINUED COVERAGE JUSTIFIED FROM A UJRANDOM POINT OF VIEW BUT DID NOT WISH TO ARGUE THE POINT WHEN ASKED TO DROP COVERAGE.

3. MORE OR LESS IN THE SAME SPIRIT, AFTER COORDINATING OUR ACTION IN ADVANCE WITH COS, WE RECENTLY PUT UNILATERAL TELEPHONE COVERAGE ON UJREADFUL. IF EVER CALLED TO TASK, WHICH WE CONSIDER MOST UNLIKELY, WE ARE PREPARED TO STATE THAT WE WERE PUZZLED THAT UPHILL DID NOT SEE FIT TO REQUEST COVERAGE ON UJREADFUL AND THEREFORE DECIDED TO ACT ON OUR OWN. IF ANYTHING SUSPICIOUS TURNS UP IN THE COVERAGE, WE ARE OF COURSE PREPARED TO BRING IT TO UPHILL'S ATTENTION WITHOUT ANY BEATING AROUND THE BUSH. ALL THINGS CONSIDERED, WE DOUBT UPHILL WOULD BE OFFENDED.
