1. In response to request in Ref. B, the following additional information concerning the involvement of the student body of the Police Officers Schools at Berlin/Charlottenburg and Piesportenberg/Necklarsburg in SIFO and SD operations in Poland in September 1939 has been provided by alias CASIDOP:

a. The operational group engaged at the outbreak of the war in Poland in September 1939 was the so-called SIFO and SD Operational Group with the 14th Army (Kampfgruppe s.b.V. der Polizei und SD bei der 14. Armee).

b. This operational group was commanded by the SS-Obergruppenführer Hugo von KOTTBACH (born 24 July 1895 in Schmonevitz), and was activated on 5 September 1939. It was composed of four battalions of Ordnungspolizei under the command of the SIFO Colonel, Dr. ALBERT KASCH (born on 7 December 1891 in Friedrichshagen). The Special SIFO Detachment was recruited from the student body of the Police Officer School in Berlin/Charlottenburg, whose commanding officer was Brigadeführer Otto HELLDIG (born on 14 February 1891 in Werdhausen) as well as from the student body of the Piesportenberg/Necklarsburg Police School, whose commanding officer was one SS-Oberführer TRIMPLER. HELLDIG's Deputy at the time was Kriminalrat SKINSCHE (born on 7 June 1901 in Bamberg on 14 February 1906 in Appertal).
