The Deutsche Sozialer Partei, founded by Gerdike, is trying to establish itself on the Federal level. Gerdike's Hamburg representative is the Otto Strasser man, Werner Diets, Hamburg Blankenese, Strömsung 61. Diets is well acquainted with the ex-Strasser man, Fritz Ziegler, Hamburg-Immoehel, Olsenroen 29. Ziegler is said to have belonged to the Waffen-SS and to the foreign intelligence services of the SD and now free-lance contributor to several Hamburg newspapers. Ziegler is trying to get in touch with all rightist groups; in the early summer of 1951 he was temporarily a police collaborator of Beck-Abelwitzer, without trying himself to the Bruderschaft. Ziegler was also a close friend of Mr. Raubert, alias Koll; he now heads the anti-communist "Bund für Freiheit" in Ham. Raubert was formerly in the Nazi propaganda minister in Berlin and Ziegler, who was an old newspaper journalist in Berlin, probably knows Raubert from that period. Source: DAB, March 12, 1951.
