Intelligence Memorandum on Toxins; planning meeting

1. Memoranda requesting your participation on this project have been sent to your respective commanders. A copy is attached for your information.

2. The drafting group will meet for the first time at 0930 on Tuesday, July 12, 1983, at CIA headquarters building, room 6E60. I suggest that each of you have your clearances perm certified to CIA for 6 or 12 months. Please use me as point-of-contact (OSWR/STD/LSB, CC)

3. The primary goals of this session are to decide the strategy to be pursued in accomplishing this analysis and to assign areas of responsibility. The items accompanying this memorandum will, I hope, provide the springboard for our discussion.

(a) The <u>precis</u> is a general description of the paper. The object of the exercise is to prepare a community-accepted prioritization of toxins as potential threat agents by considering intelligence and technical data in the context of employment. $\langle C \rangle$

(b) The <u>list of toxins</u> is a quick collection drawn from a variety of sources. It is intended to provoke thought about the compounds or classes of compounds that should be considered - for whatever reason. It also underscores the number of disparate compounds with which we will be dealing.

(c) <u>Enemy toxin use concepts</u> is a first cut at identifying scenarios. From such descriptions we will rank each of the physical properties in terms of their importance to each use situation.

(d) <u>Toxin parameters</u> lists some of the things we need to know about a compound to establish suitability for employment.

(e) The <u>toxin/standard agents</u> paper is included for the analytical method described in the appendix. A modified version of this approach may satisfy our requirement for an objective method to handle a large amount of data.
