The insurgents, meanwhile, continue to attack roads, bridges, and other targets in the region. The government plans to set up a temporary bridge over the Lempa River to replace the key Oro Bridge, which linked central El Salvador with the east until it was destroyed in 1981.	(b)(3)
Eleven US-supplied temporary Bailey bridges have been installed to replace structures damaged by the guerrillas. Press reports say the insurgents destroyed one of the bridges in La Union Department over the weekend.	(b)(3)

Prospects for success are limited, however, because of the lack of good military field commanders and material resources.
