### US State Dept Travel Advisory

### Passport/Visa Requirements

US citizens should make sure their passport will not expire for at least 3 months after they enter the country even if they do not intend to stay that long. They should also make sure they have at least 1 blank page in their passport for any entry stamp that will be required. A visa is not required as long as you do not stay in the country more than 90 days.

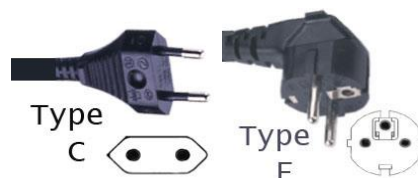

<b>Major Sports</b>	Soccer, rugby, basketball
<b>Cultural Practices</b>	Andorrans shake hands upon greeting. Men will shake with two hands, placing their left hand on the right forearm of the other person.
<b>Tipping Guidelines</b>	Tipping is optional, but welcome. Leave a 10% tip at restaurants and for taxi drivers. Round up the bill at pubs and for hotel staff.
