### US State Dept Travel Advisory

### Passport/Visa Requirements

US citizens should make sure their passport will not expire for at least 6 months after they enter the country even if they do not intend to stay that long. They should also make sure they have at least 1 blank page in their passport for any entry stamp that will be required. A visa is not required as long as the stay is less than 90 days.


Continental; cold, cloudy winters with frequent snow or rain; cool to moderately warm, cloudy, humid summers

<b>Cultural Practices</b>	Liechtenstein's workday is longer than many other countries, 8 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., albeit with a very long lunch break (officially from noon to 1:30 p.m.). So, do not be surprised if people are busy until later than might otherwise be expected. Additionally, on the country's National Day, 15 August, all residents of the principality are invited to Vaduz Castle, the prince's residence, for a reception that includes speeches and free aperitifs.
<b>Tipping Guidelines</b>	Service charges are included in most bills and further tipping is not required. Taxi fares include a service charge so no tipping is necessary.
