### **Tipping Guidelines**

Tipping 7-10% of the total billis sufficient at restaurants. Round up taxi fares. Tip bellhops loose change for carrying bags to your room. For hous ekeeping, tip 5-7% of the hotel charge per night divided by the number of days stayed.

### Souvenirs

Handmades hoes and leather goods, traditional saris, Nehru jackets, gold and bangle jewelry, furniture and lacquered decorative items, brass and wood carvings; cardamom, cinnamon, curry, saffron, and other spices; antiques

#### **Traditional Cuisine**

Khichdi — a dish of rice and lentils; Biryani — long-grain rice cooked with spices and meat and often topped with fried onion flakes and boiled eggs; Tandoori Chicken — whole chicken marinated in yogurt and spices, and baked in a tandoor (a traditional Indian clay oven)
