INTRODUCTION

The British colonized the area that is now Malaysia during the late 18th and 19th centuries. In 1948, the British-ruled territories on the Malay Peninsula (except Singapore) formed the Federation of Malaya, becoming independent in 1957. Malaysia was formed in 1963 when the former British colonies of Singapore, Sabah, and Sarawak joined the Federation. Singapore was expelled in 1965.
